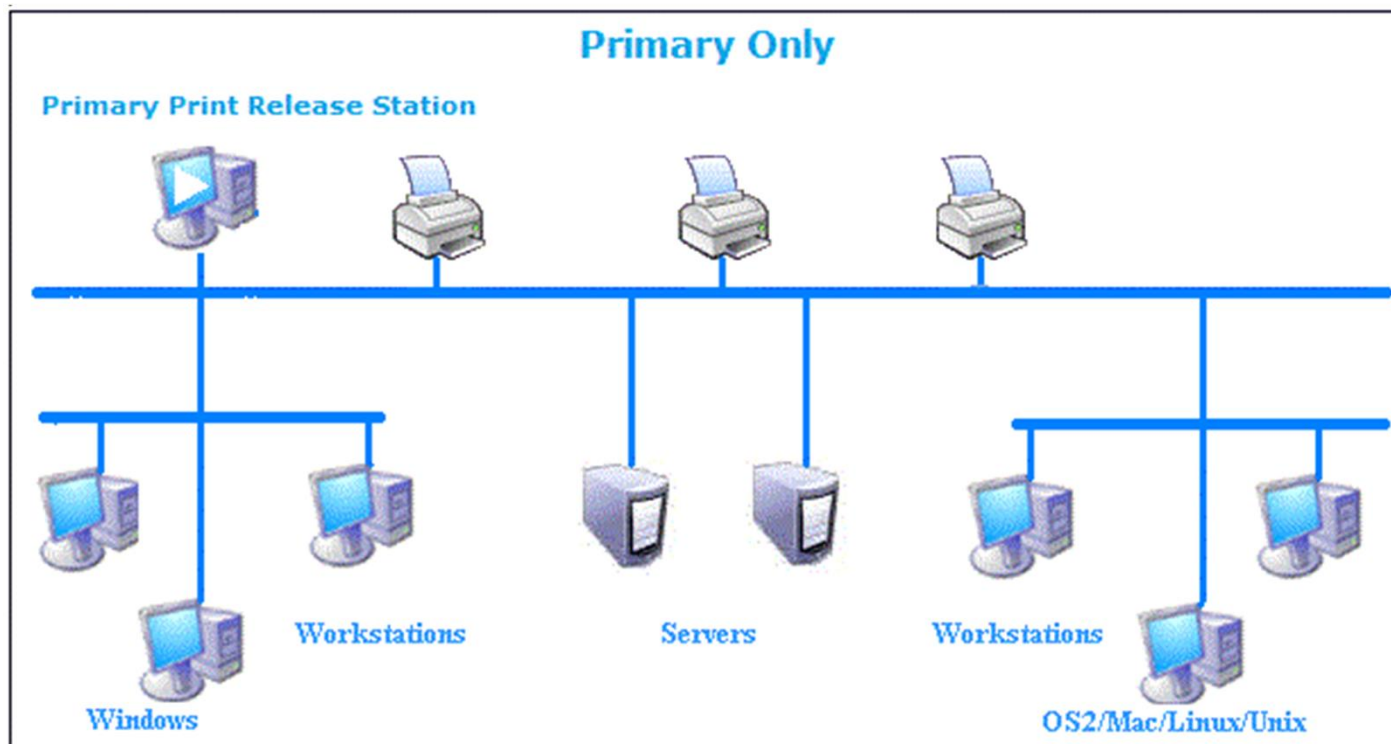


Overview

Print Release Station is a best-suited ultimate print management solution for Libraries / Schools / Colleges / Universities / Cyber Cafe Shop of low budget, where print jobs hold and release is centralized and unwanted job is restricted to reduce accidental paper wastage and abusive printing.

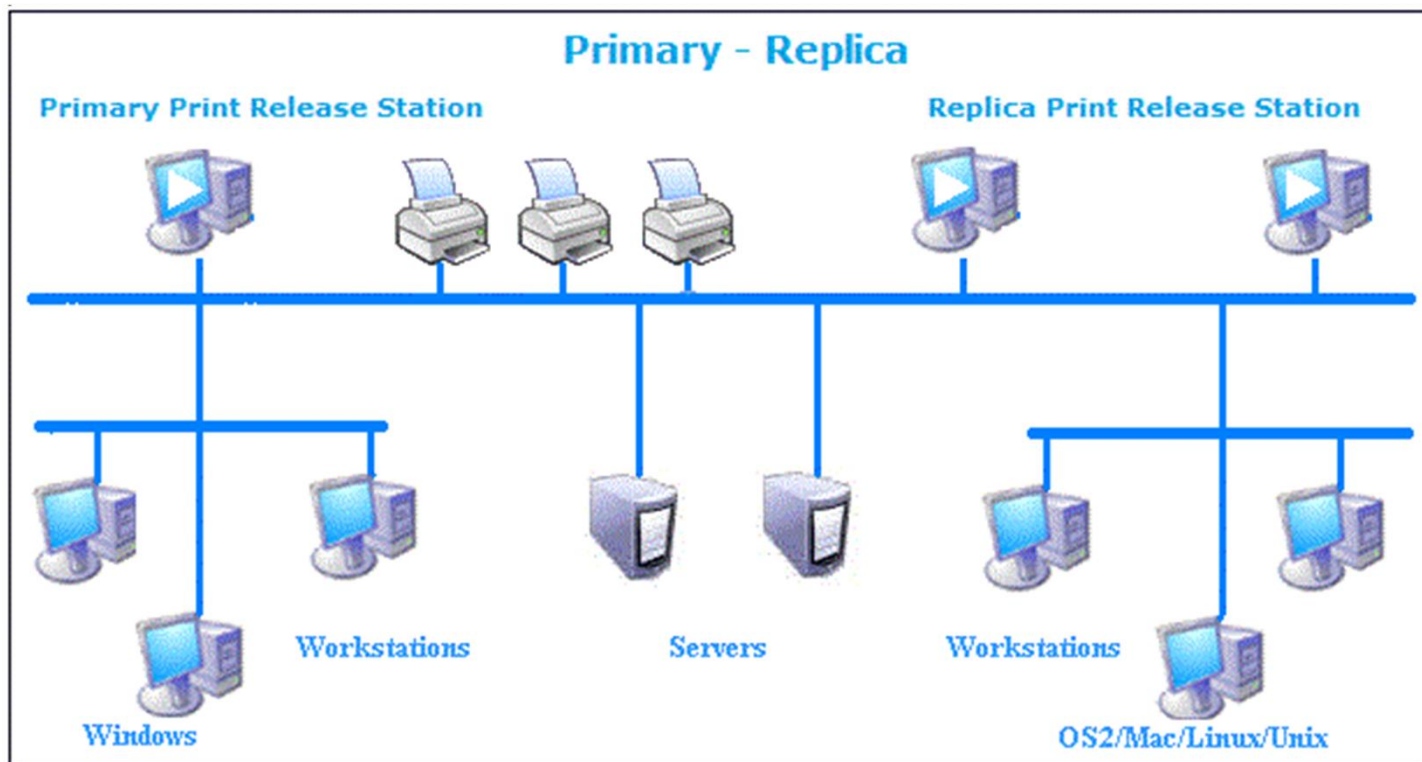
Infrastructures - Primary PRS Only

- Only Primary Print Release Station is used to hold and release all print jobs.



Infrastructures - Primary / Replica PRS

- Users can use either Primary PRS or Replica PRS to release their print jobs.



Hold / Release

- Keeps print jobs on hold until released manually by student, patron, staff or employee.
- Supports staff operation (staff mode) and unattended user operation (user mode).
- Allows to release the print jobs from any print release station.
- Automatically cancels unclaimed waiting jobs.

Staff Mode

- Staff can release the print jobs for all users.



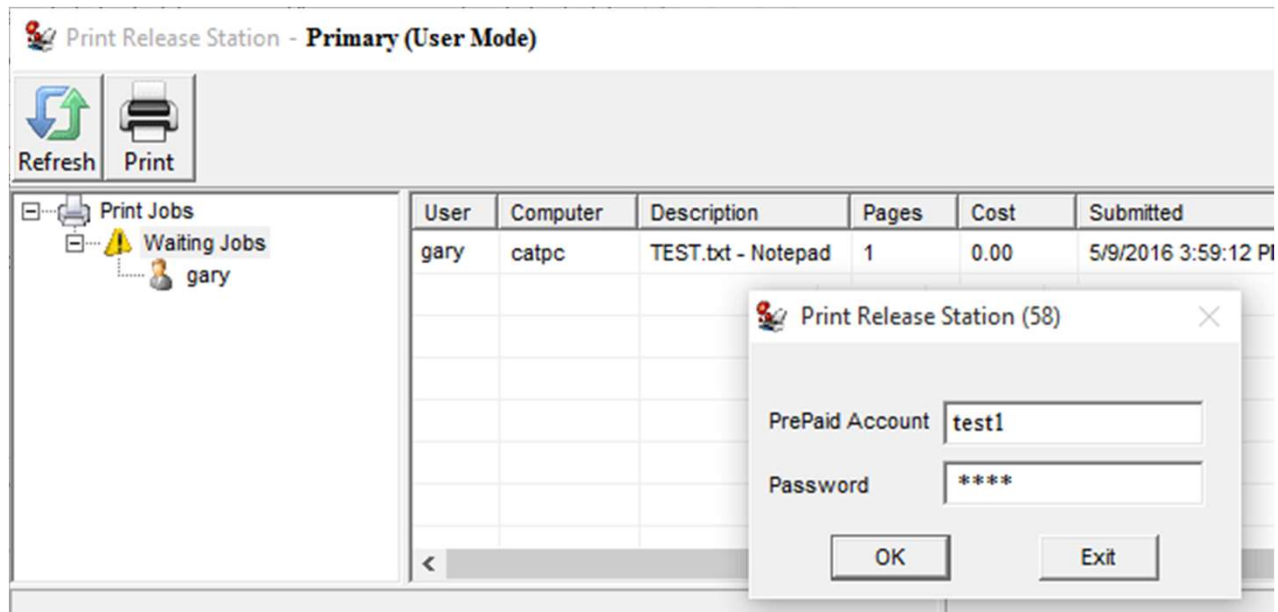

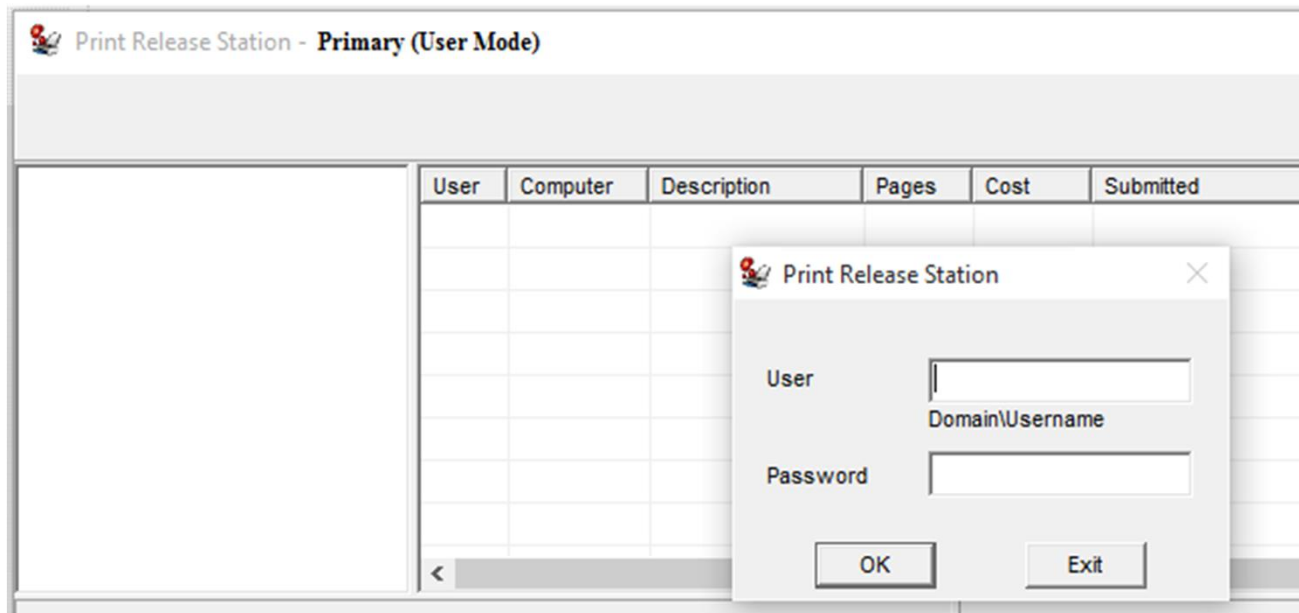
User Mode with Prepaid Account

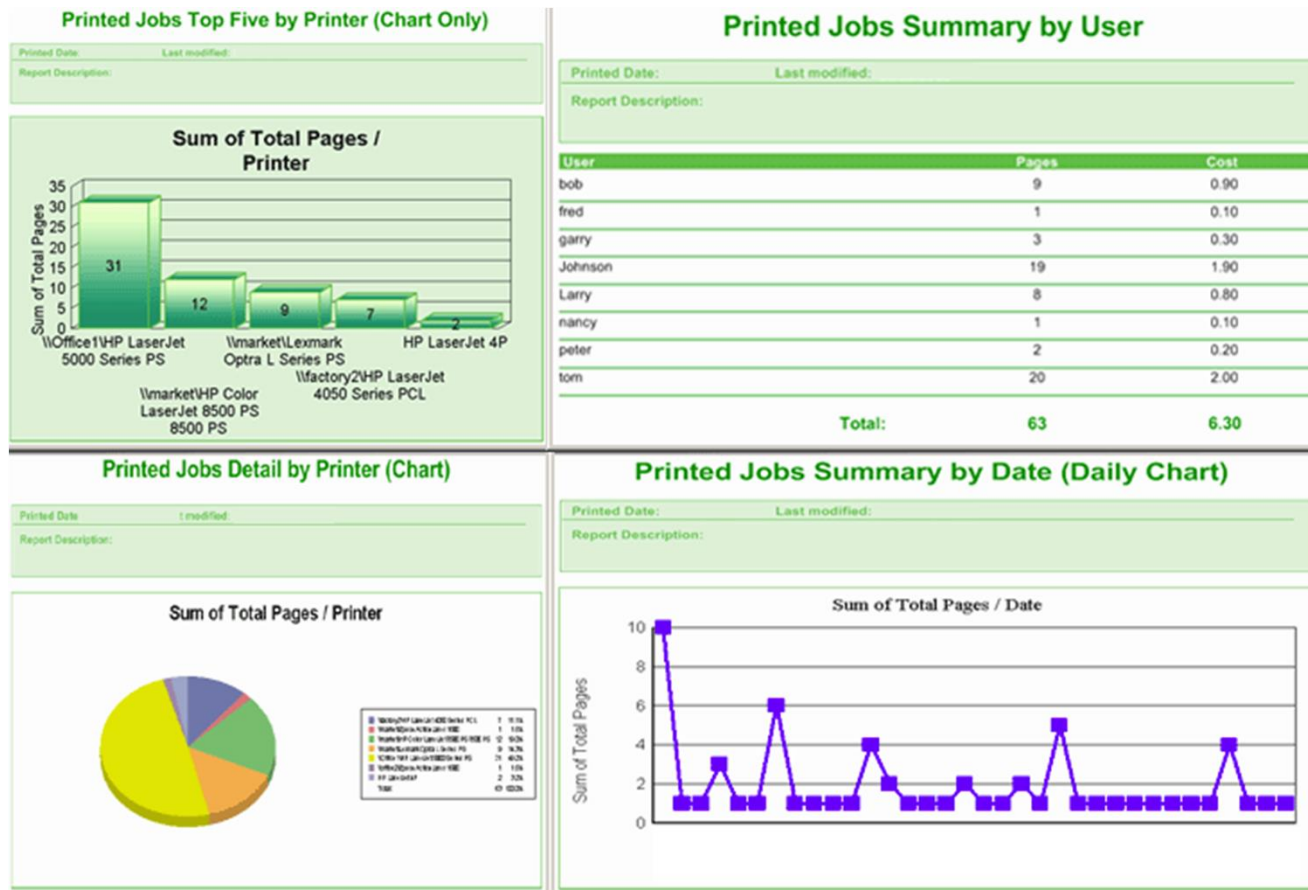
